



## Requests for Hydrant Flow Tests

To request a hydrant flow test within the Providence Water system, applicants must submit a request in writing, on company letterhead, which shall include the following:

1. Address location for the project.
2. Name of the commercial property for which the test is being requested.
3. The purpose of the test, indicating if this is for a new fire protection system design, confirmation for an existing fire system, or for insurance retest purposes.
4. If for an existing fire service, the location of the service line, and the billing account number associated with the service.
5. Specific hydrants requested to be tested, if known. Alternatively, Providence Water will select hydrants based on information furnished.
6. Name and phone number of the person to contact if it is desired to witness the test.
7. Contact name and phone number of the representative to which questions may be directed.
8. Check payable to the Providence Water Supply Board in the amount of **\$118.00**.
